memory verse cards. Print them, cut on the horizontal dashed lines, and then fold along the vertical dotted lines so that you end up with double-sided square cards. This document is A4 size, but regardless of the paper you are printing on, selecting "fit to page" in your print settings usually results in a better outcome.

The verses do not correlate with the 52 Bible Story Activities, but rather focus on God's global heart and purposes for the nations. Verses vary in length to appeal to all age levels and provide challenge. We recommend that your family memorize at least 1-2 verses each month.

SOME TIPS FOR MEMORIZING SCRIPTURE


- Do not try to memorize the whole verse in one sitting. Break it into smaller segments, memorizing a chunk at a time and adding on to what you have already memorized.
- Discuss the meaning of the verse so that you have heart knowledge, not just head knowledge.
- Talk about the context of the verse. Who is speaking? Who is the audience?
- Make sure to memorize the verse reference so your children know it is from the Bible and can look it up in the future.

- Set aside a regular time to practice the verse when your family is not rushed (before a meal, after school, while doing chores together, at bedtime).
- Create motions to go along with the verse to help make it stick in your child's mind. This also makes it more fun!
- Do not be intimidated by verse length. Your children's capacity to memorize is bigger than you think. Just spend more time memorizing longer verses.
- After you memorize a verse, reviewing it periodically so you do not forget it.


Then God blessed Noah and his sons, saying to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the earth."





Give praise to the Lord, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done.




And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation."





Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."




But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.




Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you."
